| | The Board recognizes that certain written and oral communications between students and school personnel must be confidential. |
| | § 2. <u>Authority</u> |
| | The Board directs school personnel to comply with all federal and state laws, regulations and Board policy concerning confidential communications of students. |
| | § 3. <u>Guidelines</u> |
| 22 PA Code § 12.12 | Information received in confidence from a student may be revealed to the student's parent/guardian, designated administrator or other appropriate authority by the staff member who received the information when the health, welfare or safety of the student or other persons clearly is in jeopardy. |
| 22 PA Code § 12.12 42 Pa. C.S.A. § 5945, 8337 | Use of a student's confidential communications to school personnel in legal proceedings is governed by statutes and regulations appropriate to the proceedings. |
| | § 4. <u>Delegation of Responsibility</u> |
| | In qualifying circumstances, a staff member may reveal confidential information to the building principal and other appropriate authorities. |
| | In qualifying circumstances, the designated administrator may reveal confidential information to a student's parent or legal guardian and other appropriate authorities, including law enforcement personnel. |
